

PROGRAMS OFFERED

1. Bachelor of Science in Psychotherapy (Psychosocial Counselling)

Duration: 4 Years

Entry Requirements: Full MSCE certificate or its equivalent with six (6) credits including English and Mathematics.

This program provides training in psychological therapy, crisis intervention, and mental health care. Graduates work in hospitals, schools, and community settings, providing counselling and therapy services to individuals facing mental health challenges.





2. Bachelor of Science in Psychotherapy (Psychosocial Counselling) Upgrading

• This is a 2-year full time programme.

Admission requirements:

- MSCE with 6 credits including English & Mathematics
- Diploma in Counselling/Psychosocial Counselling
- 2 years post qualification work experience

3. Bachelor of Science in Mental Health - Psychiatric Nursing (Upgrading)

Duration: 2 Years

Entry Requirements: Full MSCE certificate with six credits

Focus: This program is designed for students who wish to specialize in psychiatric nursing, providing care and support for individuals with mental health conditions in hospitals, rehabilitation centres, and community health settings.



Applicants to this program must;

- Be Registered Nurses or Registered Nurse/Midwives with University Diploma.
- Have a minimum of two years' post-qualification clinical/work experience.
- Have a full Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with six (6) credits in English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics and any other subject.
- Have current registration with the professional regulatory bodies of the nursing profession in their country e.g., the Nurses and Midwives Council of Malawi for Malawian applicants.

4. Bachelor of Science in Nursing and Midwifery - Generic

Duration: 4 Years

Entry Requirements: Full MSCE certificate six (6) credits in English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics and any other subject.

5. University Certificate in Midwifery

Duration: 1 Year

Entry Requirements: Full MSCE or it's equivalent with six credits including, English, Physics, Chemisry, Biology, Mathematics and any other subject.

Focus: This program prepares students for professional nursing and midwifery practice, equipping them with the necessary skills in patient care, maternal and child health, and hospital-based clinical experience.

6. Bachelor of Science in Clinical Medicine - Mental Health (Upgrading)

Duration: 2 Years

Focus: This course equips students with the skills to diagnose and treat mental health conditions. program includes both theoretical and practical training in psychiatric and hospitals clinics, preparing students for work various healthcare in settings.





Applicants to this program must;

 Be qualified general Clinical Officers with a Diploma in Clinical Medicine. Those with Diploma in Mental Health and Clinical Psychiatry are also eligible.



- Have a full Malawi School Certificate of Education (MSCE) or its equivalent with six (6) credits in English, Physical Science/ Physics & Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics and any other two subjects.
- Currently be registered with the professional regulatory body governing clinical medicine practice in their respective countries e.g., the Medical Council of Malawi for Malawian applicants.

7. Diploma in Clinical Medicine (Generic & Upgrading)

Generic

Duration: 3 Years

Entry Requirements:

 Full MSCE certificate or equivalent with six (6) credits in English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics and any other subject.

Focus: This diploma prepares students to work as clinical officers in general medical practice. The upgrading option is available for those who wish to advance their skills and qualifications.

Upgrading

Duration: 2 Years

Applicants to this program must:

- Be qualified medical Assistants with certificate in Clinical Medicine
- Have full Malawi School
 Certificate of Education
 (MSCE) or its equivalent
 with a credit pass in English
 and any other two credits in
 either Biology,
 Mathematics, Physical
 Science or Chemistry and
 Physics.
- Currently be registered with the professional regulatory body governing clinical medicine practice.

This diploma prepares students to work as clinical officers in general medical practice. The upgrading option is available for those who wish to advance their skills and qualifications.

8. Bachelor of Science in Public Health (New Program)

Duration: 4 Years

Entry Requirements: Full MSCE certificate six (6) credits in English, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics and any other subjects

Focus: This new program aims to train public health professionals in disease prevention, health promotion, and policy implementation. Graduates will work in government agencies, NGOs, and healthcare institutions to improve community health outcomes.
